### **Borrowing**

You can borrow media in the Central Lending Library located in the Schloss Westflügel, where you will also find the textbook collection. The books in the subject libraries can only be used on site.



# Workplaces

In the subject libraries, there are individual workstations for concentrated study and study rooms for group work. You can read and study in the subject libraries seven days a week, including weekends and public holidays.
