

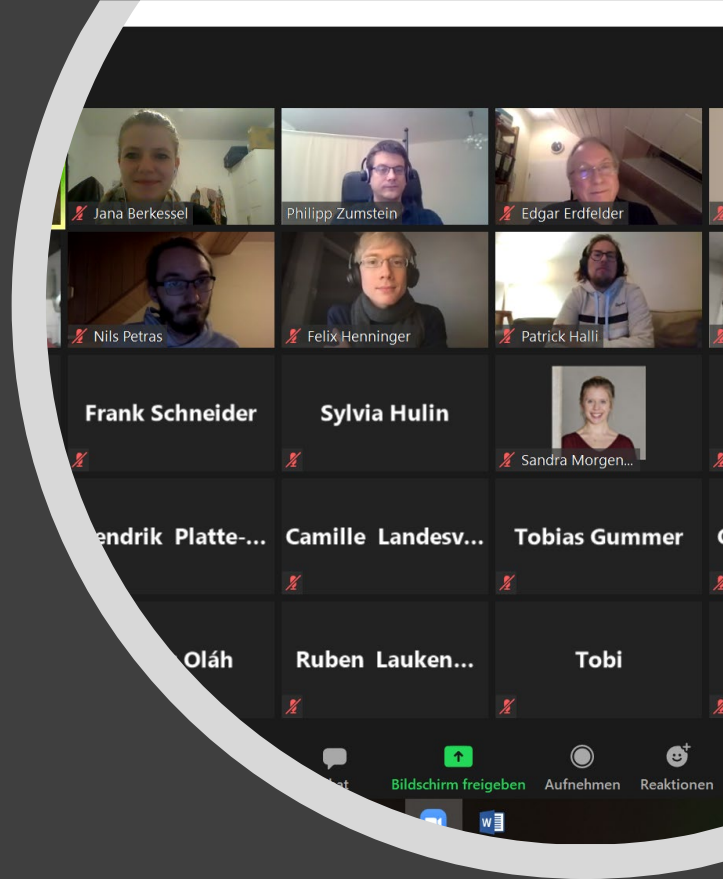

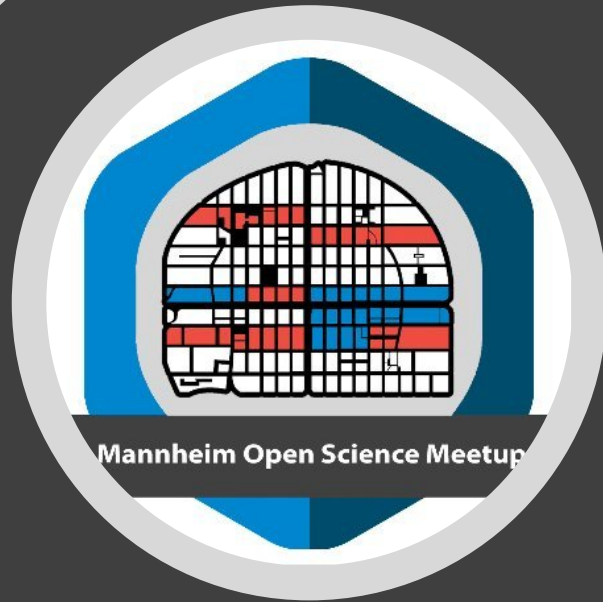

Mannheim Open Science Meetup is a grassroots initiative founded by students and postdocs from various disciplines and research institutions at the University of Mannheim. It provides a space for local academics to share knowledge around transparent scientific practices.

Since its inception in the fall of 2019, a small organizing team has successfully engaged scientists, introducing pertinent topics through talks and workshops, connecting colleagues across disciplines to share their expertise.
