What is the GRN?

- Peer-led cross-disciplinary consortium, which aims to foster reproducibility, trustworthiness and openess of scientific research on a national level
- Activities:
- -Promotion of training and education on open science practices
- -Bringing stakeholders together
- Various exchange formats (e.g., virtual brainstorming events, workshops)
- Founded on February 1, 2021
- 40 members (as of September 2024)
 - 35 Reproducibility Initiatives
 - 4 Research Institutions
 - 1 Academic Society
